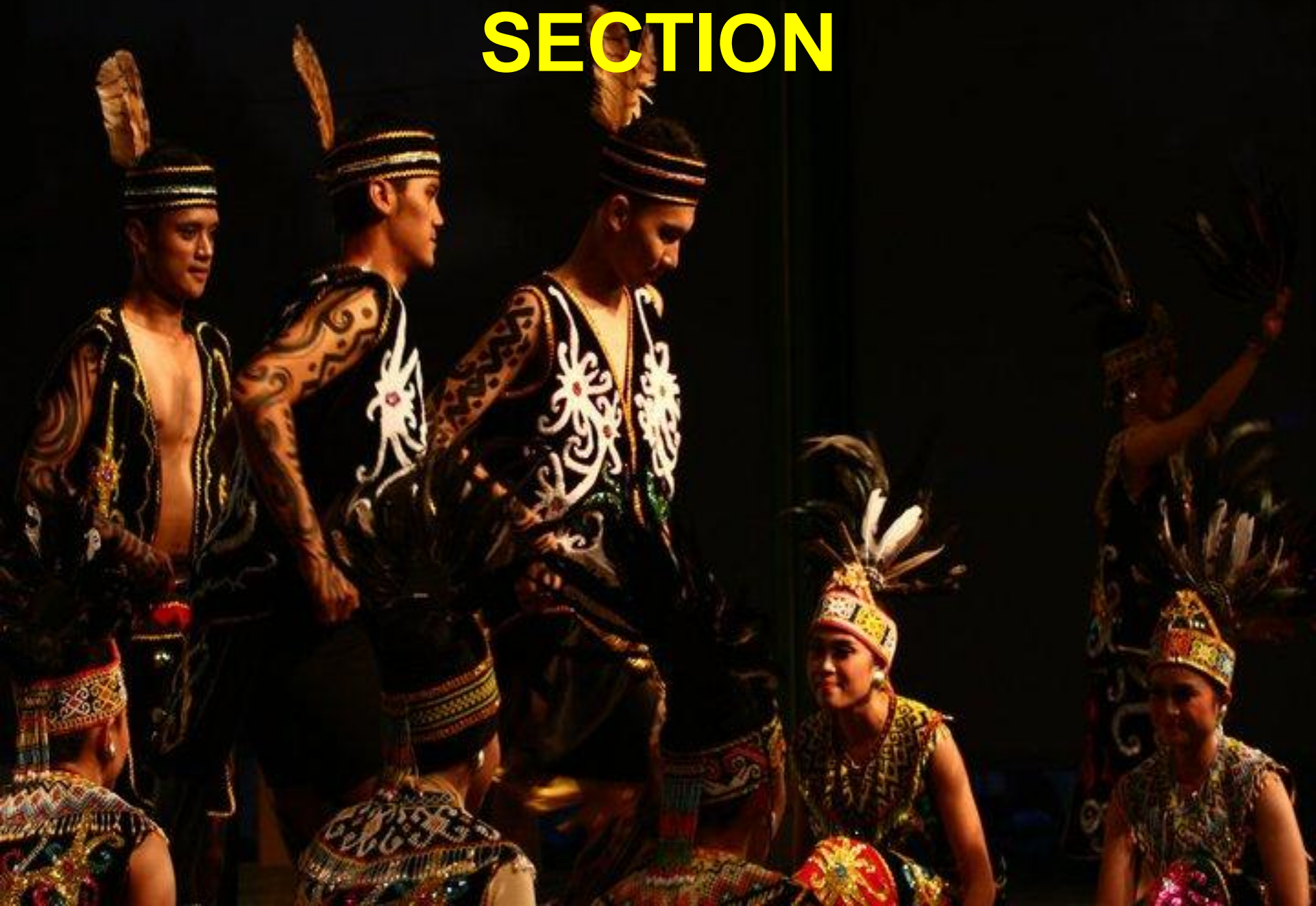

IOV (International Organization Volkenvurst) is a world wide organization of individuals and institutions working to document, preserve, and promote all forms of folk art, both tangible and intangible in Belgium in 1979. The UNESCO Convention on the Safeguarding of the Intangible Cultural Heritage, with emphasis on research and documentation, provides the framework for IOV Program and Projects



The IOV Youth Program and Commission were officially formed at the 2007 General Assembly. Recognizing that the youth of today are the leaders of tomorrow, UNESCO has encouraged Non-Governmental Organizations (NGOs) to form youth programs in order to prepare young people for the work that lies ahead.

IOV was one of the first to successfully establish a youth commission. In 2009, the First IOV World Youth Congress was held in the United States, with more than 120 young IOV members from 40 countries participating in 4 days of lectures, demonstrations and activities focusing on topics related to the Intangible Cultural Heritage.
