Introduction

- * Smile Action Project A community service NGO giving out free oral health treatment
- * Green & Blue Group An NGO advocates for sustainable urban living, focusing on solid waste management.

Rationale

- * Poor oral hygiene amongst orang asli in Malaysia.
- * Limited job opportunity in villages of orang asli in Malaysia.

Objective

- * Improve oral hygiene among orang asli with maximum approaches
- * Introduce Takakura home composting method to them as another source of income via selling compost.

Target Groups

- * Settlement of orang asli: Pos Bersih (Bagan Datok, Perak), Gombak (Selangor), Ulu Yam (Selangor)
- * Numbers of targets: ~500

Action Plan (1)

- * Dentists and volunteers will be called to enter the settlements and do preparation (set up, etc).
- * Introduction of oral hygiene, interactive games and workshop on composting to be conducted.

Action Plan (2)

- * A composting site will be set up in/nearby each settlement.
- * Contact each waste contractor to send over the food waste to these sites for composting
- * Contact potential compost buyers, publicity and marketing will be involved.

Time-frame

- * Pre-action (Jan): Plan, contact and equipment preparation
- * Febuary- March: Visits to orang asli settlement
- * April: Building of Composting site, food waste collection
- * May & June: Operation, collection and marketing for compost
- * Post-action: Observation and evaluation

Budget

- * RM10,000 for treatment part
- * RM5,000 for building each composting site, maintenance, man power.
- * Funding resources: through company CSR programmes, monetary donations, public sectors, NGOs.
