Problem

- Very low rate of awareness among students in RO Korea on natural disasters
- Education on natural disasters, especially floods, is needed as they are becoming prevalent in Korea due to climate change
- Lack of programs and educational materials aimed at engaging youth in learning about disasters

Objective

 Provide an opportunity for students to think creatively and actively about different aspects of natural disasters

Motivate them to cooperate in the thinking process in order to form stronger ideas

Encourage them to be more responsible about the situation in Korea

Method

- Host a picture essay competition
 - -combination of both drawing and writing

2-4 participants in a group

Target: Middle school and high school students in RO Korea

Format

A drawing of any type (painting, cartoon, etc)

An essay of any type (personal, formal, etc)



Ex. Once upon a time in Korea there was a happy family. However, one day a big flood destroyed their house and left them homeless. They had to move to a shelter and depend on the food provided by the organization. They did not know what to do because they had never really prepared for natural disasters.....

Theme

- Main theme: Thinking about Natural Disasters
- Things to think about: the current situation of Korea in regards to natural disasters
- Subtheme:
- 1. Personal experiences with natural disasters
- 2. Ways the youth can build disaster resilience in their own communities.
- 3. Ways to engage others to raise awareness

People to People Korea

Will invite other high school and university students of related clubs to take part in the organizing process

Funding

Prize awards - USD 200

Advertising fee – USD 50

Timeline (2012)

- Late August/Early September: Contact organization that will be willing to help
- September: Plan and prepare the competition
- Early October: Promote
- Late October: Start the competition for a duration of 3 weeks
- Late November: Judging and award ceremony

Potential plans

- Host the competition annually
- 2013 : host in Nepal (through NGO 'NEKOFF')
- extend the participants to include foreigners in Korea through Seoul Global Center or international affairs department of universities
