STATISTICS

- 2011- World's most disaster-hit country with 50 documented natural disasters.
- 2012 third most disaster-prone country in the world (after Tonga and Vanuatu).
- Topped the list of countries with the highest mortality rate (2,360 people killed) due to natural disasters in 2012.

PREPAREDNESS

- The Philippines is one of the most prepared countries for the onslaught of natural disasters (World Bank, 2013).
- According to the report, the Philippines got a 3.25 percent average risk identification indicator, joining the more prepared countries such as Thailand (3.5 percent), Indonesia (3.75 percent), Japan (four percent), and Malaysia with the highest at 4.25 percent.
