SMOKE HAZE DISASTER

The smoke haze incited by forest fire from illegal activities of palm oil plantation owners and local people has been engulfing the province in the past month.


It's been risking respiratory illness to people living in regencies across the province. As before, roughly half of the fires are burning on land managed by pulpwood, <u>palm oil</u>, and logging companies.

Indonesia's Disaster Management Agency, Dramatic satellite images of heavy smoke plumes show the large amount of pollutants being discharged to the atmosphere. The fires are extensive in areas with deep peat soils, suggesting high volumes of carbon are being released, contributing to


"climate change".


