The Foundation

The Children's Charter on DRR (2011)

1. Schools must be safe and education must not be interrupted
2. Child protection must be a priority before, during and after a disaster
3. Children have the right to participate and to access the information they need
4. Community infrastructure must be safe, and relief and reconstruction must help reduce future risk
5. Disaster Risk Reduction must reach the most vulnerable people

Budget Scenarios

Indicators only (Est. \$10,000 USD)

Analysis of 100-200 Action Plans; Formal consultation process;
Continuous review; Media & PR launch; Ongoing negotiation etc.



Indicators + Best Practice Guide (Est. \$30,000 USD)

Printing and distribution; In-depth analysis of 200-400 action plans;
Formation of a management committee; Interactive website etc.



Indicators + Best Practice Guide + Youth Forum (Est. \$100,000 USD)

Venue, catering and logistics supporting up to 100 youth delegates;
Accommodation and expenses incurred for guest speakers etc.
