KOBE RMC: Background



- Little communication between local community and Foreign students.
- Little communication even among local community, especially between young and elderly.
- Foreign students are not familiar with the earthquake.
- Basic information about DRR is in Japanese.

KOBE RMC: Action Plan

KOBE RMC: TIME LINE
