YOUTH PEACE AM BASSADORS (YPA) INTERNATIONAL TRAINING WORKSHOPS ARE ORGANISED BY EUBIOS ETHICS INSTITUTE SINCE 2010.

- 640 youth joined 10 YPA training workshops so far.
- The participants have made 250
 action plans for developing peace and many plans have been completed.
- Since 2013 held in cooperation with American University of Sovereign Nations (AUSN).
- Usually 5 days of intense training, and development of action plans.


Also from some of the action plans developed in different countries and discussions with Prof. Macer.

Where is Mariveles Bataan in Philippines?










SOME LANDMARKS















RATIONALE
