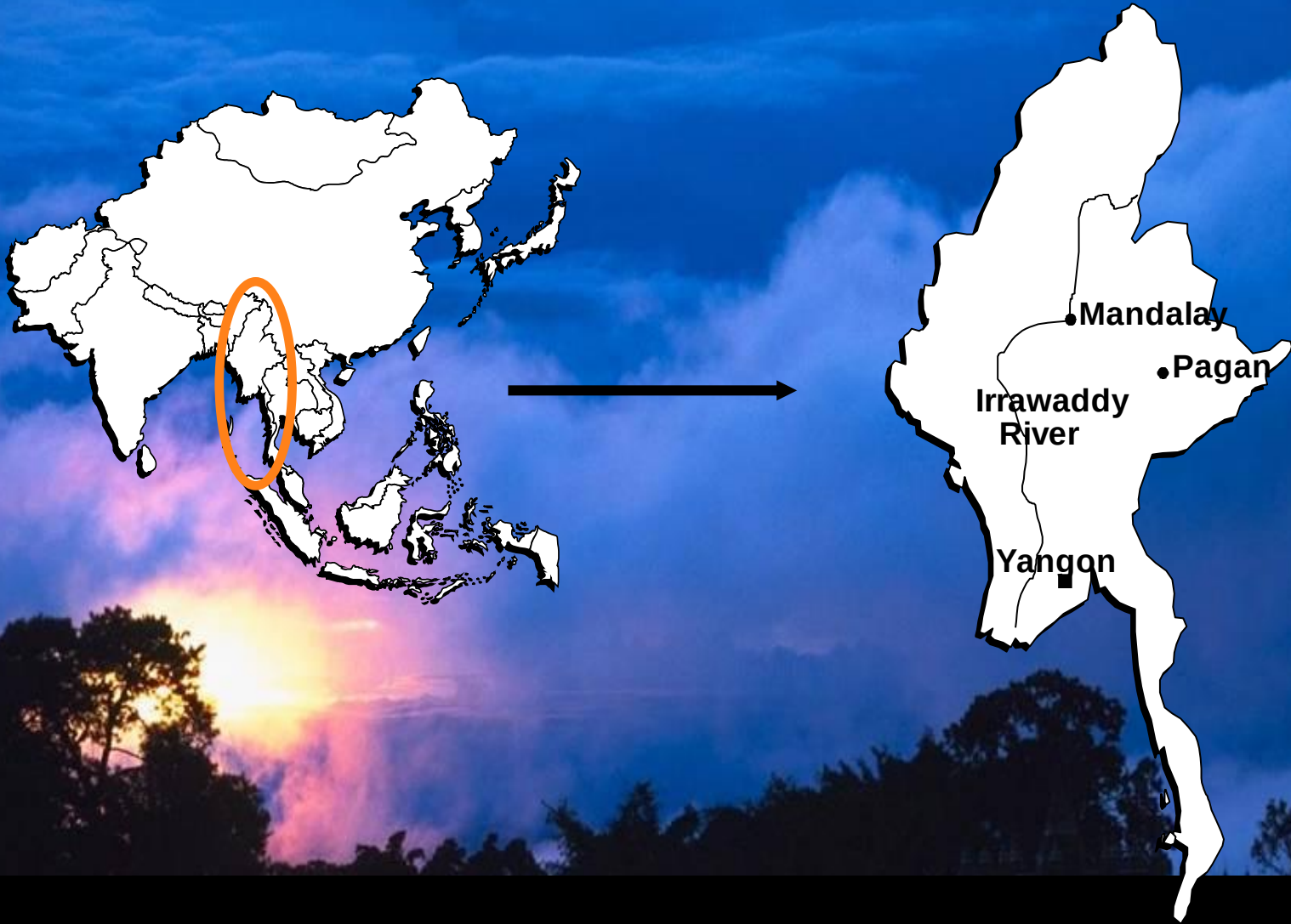

Background and Problem Statement

- ▶ Civil wars from ethnic conflicts.
- ▶ Conflicts delay building the national economy and social systems.
- ▶ One of the underlying reasons is lack of peace education which can process to violence dominant actions.

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Goals

- Public awareness about conflicts and civil wars.
 - Anti-violence approach and peace building.
 - Public motivation on national issues and solutions.
 - Peace in term of unity and security.
 - Advocating the stakeholders for peaceful ways of state building.
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Work plan

1. Setting up the working committee with main administration and mobile team.
 2. Recruiting the field experts, key activators.
 3. Situational analysis and gap analysis.
 4. Agenda setting for peace education and civic engagement.
 5. Preparation for research activities; methodology and titles for opinion polls.
 6. Planning and establishing the outreach activities including cultural exchange.
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Obstacles and Constraints

- ▶ Restrictions in some conflict areas.
 - ▶ Terrible infrastructure in going to very remote areas.
 - ▶ Violent nature of people in some conflicted areas.
 - ▶ Personal security of the mobile team.

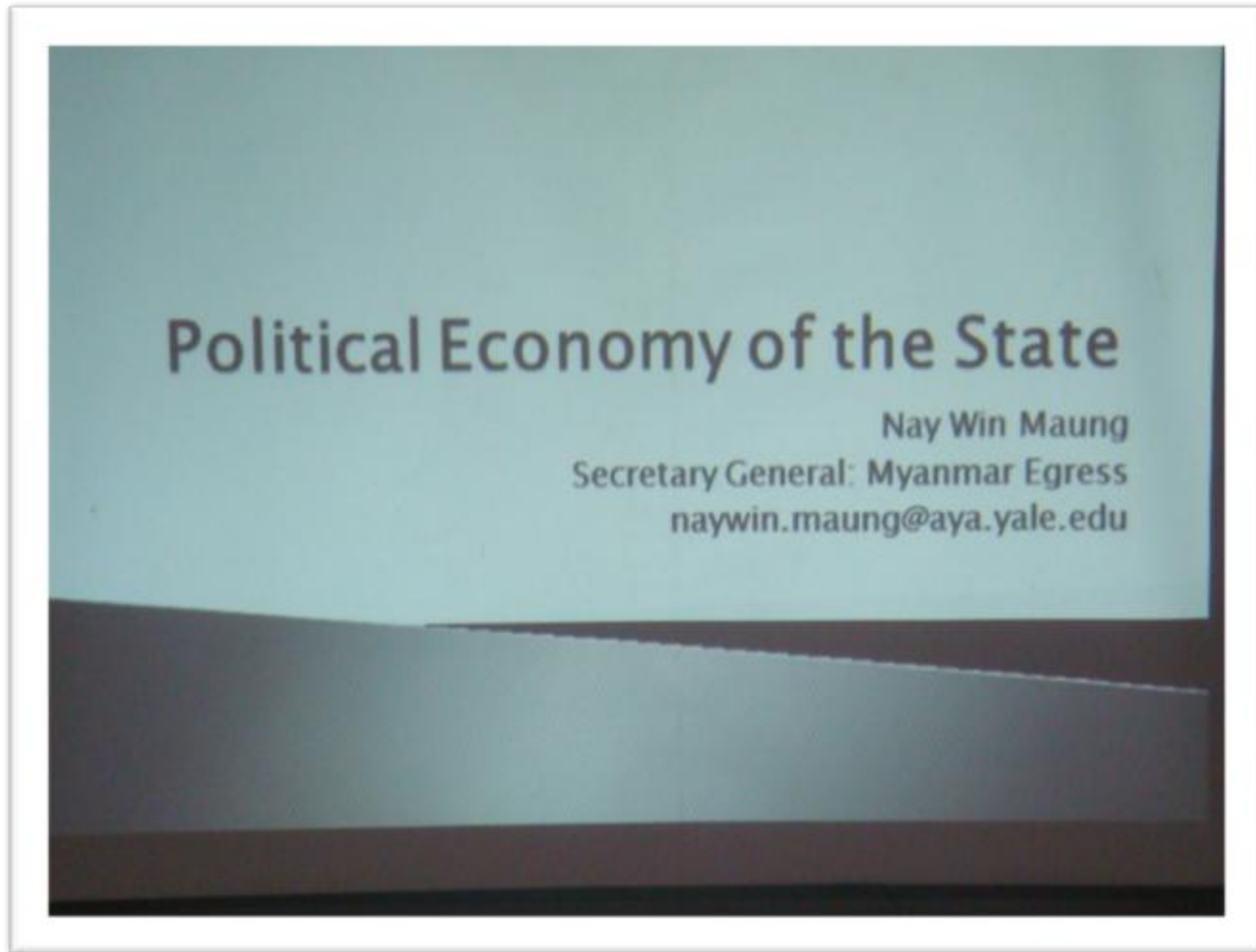
