Born to Shine Teens Outreach

- * African with a population estimate of over 1 billion, UN estimate 2013, who are mainly over 60 % youth, then arise the challenge of fine-tuning numerical strength to economic strength and peace development
- * Teenage delinquencies, alarming high school drop out rates, sex abuse, drug addiction, human trafficking, peer pressures and insufficient good role models for the teens

* Problem Statement

*To create a positive change in the Society

*Objective

- * 1000 African Teenagers within the age of 13 to 19 in High Schools and Lower Class drop out in the community
- * To develop Unstoppable peace ambassadors who will shine light in the community in spite of all challenges to achieve academic excellence, role models to younger generation and promote global leaders for sustainable development

* **Specific Target**

- * Born to Shine Facebook Page
- * Organizing youth peace events in High Schools where seminars on peace education will be given
- * Distribution of “Think Big, Dr. Ben Carson’s books to participants”
- * Watching of peace promoting movies e.g. The Beautiful Mind, Gifted hands, The Sound of Music, The Courageous, Fighting the Giants, The Wrath of Cain, My Daughter the terrorist, Kids are alright, etc.
- * Singing of I have a Dream Peace Song by Participants

* **Activities**

- * This training workshop spread over one year period and performance evaluation on peace in the community by their teachers and community leaders as follow up in the community
- * 1200 USD for “Think Big Books for Teenagers
- * 150 USD for transportation
- * 300 USD for electronic gadgets and buying movies
- * 50 USD for certificates
- * 100 USD for follow up activities
- * 100 USD for Miscellaneous expenses
- * Total of 1900 USD

*Timeline and Costing

- * Preparation starts 17th June, 2013, with consultation with stakeholders in Nigeria, West Africa, where implementation of the training takes place on August 27th, 2013 and the follow up starts immediately.
