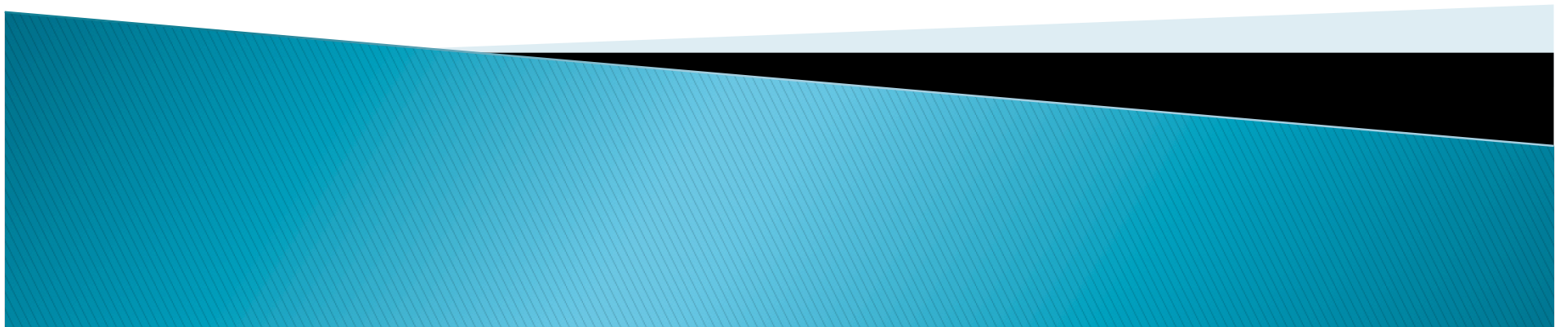

Setting an example for other cities



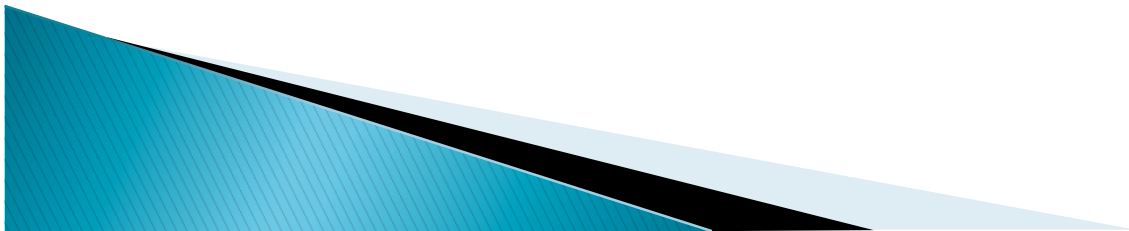
Objective for the Concert

- ▶ To set an example for other cities to follow



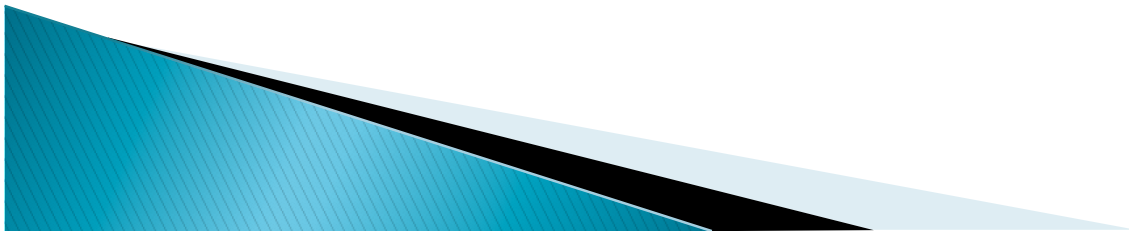
Target Group

- ▶ Performers: Mainly Junior and Senior High Students, Professional groups and individuals are also welcomed as guests.
- ▶ Audience: Any person can come and watch the concert. Admission fee is charged, however the capacity of the hall is 230 people
- ▶ Virtual Audience: Any people of authority from aboard



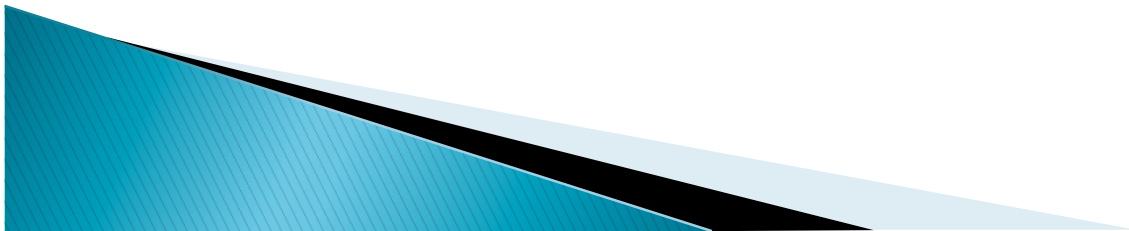
Current Condition of Concert

- ▶ Aim of Total Performers (including guest)
 - About 40 to 50 groups
- ▶ Total Confirmed Performers (excluding guest)
 - 19 groups
- ▶ Total Confirmed Performers with application forms submitted
 - 10 groups
- ▶ Total Pending Performers
 - At least 40 groups
- ▶ Estimated Total (including guests)
 - 50 groups



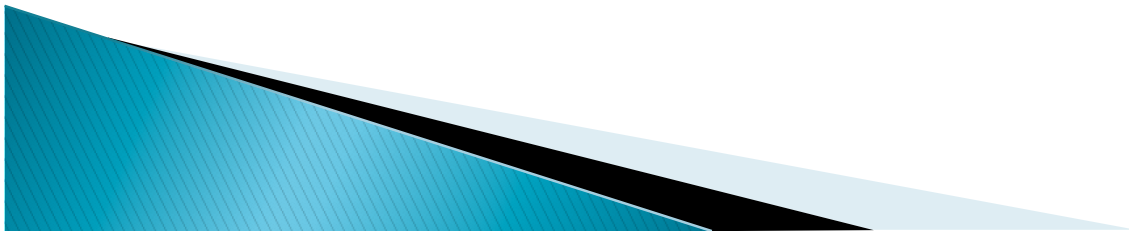
My role

- ▶ Chairman (実行委員長) of the concert
 - Seek for performers (divided job amongst many people)
 - Accept applications (both performers and display)
 - Organize the bits and pieces of the event (with the executive committee (実行委員))



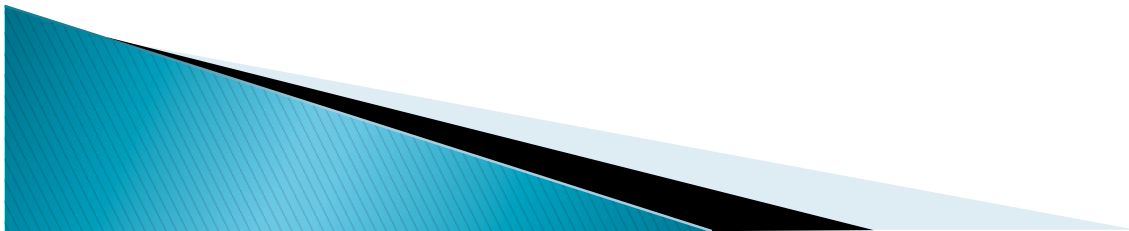
Stakeholders

- ▶ Hiroshima City International House
 - Venue for concert

 - Providing executive committee staff and window for receiving applications

 - This section is pending. If anyone could help us find a sponsor, it will be greatly appreciated.



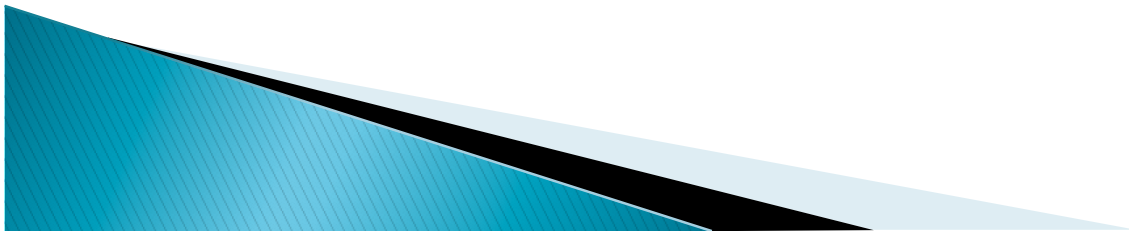
Timeframe

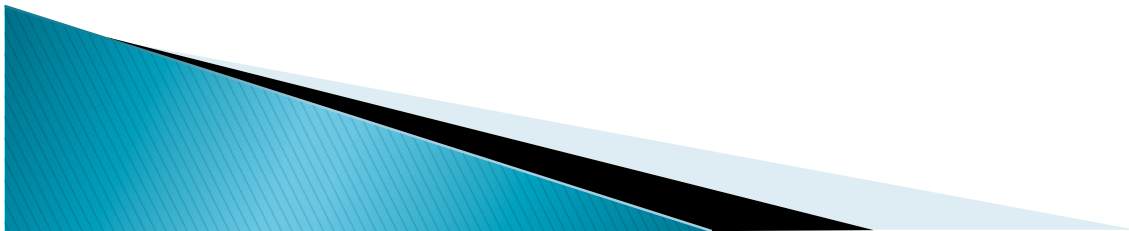
