Introducing Our Action Plan

When: 7 May, 2011, Clean up Day of Institute of Foreign Languages, Phnom Penh, Cambodia

Participants: Around 200 – 300 students joined the event every year.

Activities:

1. Self-Introduction (10mn)

- In this presentation, we will briefly share what we have learnt from the UNESCO Youth Peace Ambassador Training Workshop to participants.

2. Presentation (15mn)

- **“Green and Clean => Peace with Nature”** – By In Sophearun, UNESCO Youth Peace Ambassador Trainee.

Activities:

3. Peace & Nature Quizzes (25mn)

- The purpose of this game show is to raise the awareness and love of individuals, especially youths about environmental protection.
- In this game, there are 4 main rounds.
- Nine students will be chosen randomly.
- All of them will be divided into three different groups for competition.
- Three students will compete in each round and one winner will be selected.
- After students finish the 3rd round, all the three selected winners will compete in the final round.
- At the end of the game, rewards will be given to winners in the place of 1st, 2nd, 3rd.

Activities:

- At least 40 quizzes are needed.
- Rewards for contest winners should be made from recycled products.
- Rewards should be handed in to the contest winners by Director of Department or RUPP Rector or Lecturers.

4. Further Action Plan Presentation (5mn)

- Further action plan might be held in October, when new academic year starts.
