VISION

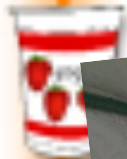
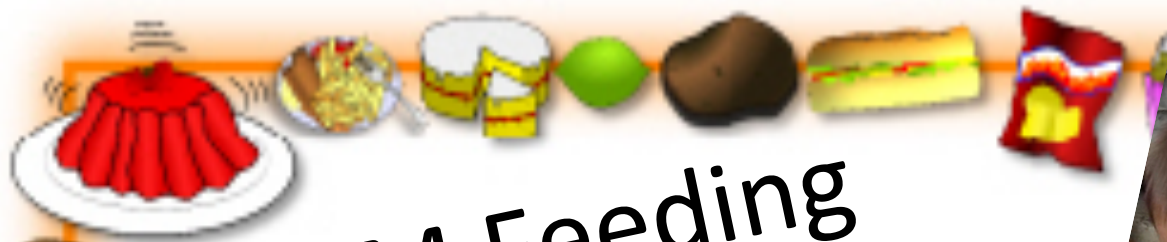
-To minimize malnutrition in our partner communities whilst advocating peace.

-Children ages 6 years old and below



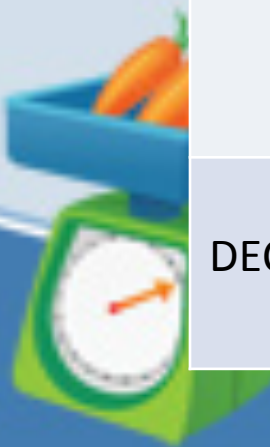


Budget needed
